



Notification of the Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission
Re: Intent of Integrity on the Organizational Management of
the Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission

The Office of the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission (NBTC) recognizes and gives priority to the implementation of the anti-corruption control scheme in the public sector, which the Royal Thai Government has declared in the National Anti-Corruption Strategy: Phase 3 (2017-2021) along with the 20-Year National Strategy (2018-2037) to achieve the vision of “Zero Tolerance and Clean Thailand”. The missions are targeted to create a culture which does not tolerate corruption, enhance good governance in integrative administration of the country, and reform the entire anti-corruption regime to equal the international standards.

I would thereby like to pledge my intent of integrity and herein affirm that I shall lead the Office of the NBTC to meet accomplishments as stated in our vision, mission and core value with integrity, virtue as well as transparency, in collaboration with concerned stakeholders to prevent and suppress corruption. I shall stand prompt to be monitored my work performance as pledged in earnest. Hence, the NBTC personnel shall perform their duties for public interest with integrity, rightfulness, fairness, transparency and accountability as follows:

1. **Duty performance** Perform duties with integrity, rightfulness and transparency in accordance with the Good Governance Policy.
2. **Budget management** Manage budgeting as per cost-effectiveness scheme for public interest.
3. **Exercise of power** Implement personnel administration with rightfulness and fairness.
4. **Management of government property** Manage government property rightfully.
5. **Anti-corruption control** Implement the anti-corruption action plan and regularly monitor its efficiency.
6. **Quality of duty performance** Strictly perform duties with virtue in accordance with prescribed process, standards and timelines for public interest.

7. **Efficiency of communication** Develop, as prescribed by law, open and complete communication that is conveniently accessible for receiving views and complaints concerning corruption.
8. **Improvement of work system** Use technology to develop and improve relevant work process so as to meet client needs and increase transparency.
9. **Disclosure of information** Disseminate, as prescribed by law, up-to-date information that is complete and conveniently accessible.
10. **Anti-corruption prevention** Disclose up-to-date information concerning operations and internal measures for anti-corruption.
